There will be a limit on the number of exhibitors allowed into the building for check in. If possible, have one person check in exhibits. Masks must be worn during check in. We encourage exhibitors to print their judge's sheets, pre-fill them and attach them to their exhibits and pre-fill exhibit tags. Exhibit tags will be available for pick up at the Extension Office Front Desk as of Monday, January 11, 2020. If you do not have an exhibit tag prior to arrival, you will be asked to complete them in your cars.

Items will be judged on Friday, January 22<sup>nd</sup>.
